<u>Committee Membership</u>: At the last meeting of the Health & Human Services board, new members/changes to the CST committee were approved. New members are as follows: Cindy Robinson will be on the committee but may appoint designee, Katherine Burrow, Marjorie Fillyah, and Stacy Smith.

**<u>2021 CST Budget Updates</u>**. There are \$60,000 total allocations for the CST program designated from Wisconsin Department of Health Services. The agency will re-apply for this grant in August 2021 for the 2022 calender year.

There are 72 total allocation for 2021. Each year when the agency applies, some dollars are set aside for certain areas, such as overhead to keep things moving within the unit. Money is allocated as well for training of in house staff as well as parents of clients. Money is also set aside for activities but need to be lined out in the service plan for that client utilizing it.

**Coordinated Services Team CST) Enrollment Status:** There are currently 28 youth who are in the program and each child the agency is currently working with are dually enrolled in both CST and CCS programs.

<u>CST COVID Updates</u>: The main building continues to be closed to the public. Staff continue to provide services virtually and in person on an individual basis.
