5. Brief status report on the Richland Economic Development structural documents.

Director Glasbrenner confirmed that the County Board currently has the documents to review at their next meeting. M. Brewer states that the main discussion will be to add more voting board members. M. Breininger questioned if someone will speak on behalf of the RED Board at the county meeting and M. Brewer indicated that he would.

6. Report regarding City efforts to acquire land for housing.

There is no pending land acquisition by the City of RC. Story Field was acquired recently. Discussion regarding costs of construction, land availability, infrastructure. T. Coppernoll said that there was a request for additional funds through a current city TIF district for Panorama Building #2 as a result of increased construction costs. The City is reviewing the request for additional funds. T. Coppernoll reviewed the housing shortage situation, and how tax revenue is generated through net new construction. J. Collins, City Council, recommended that the City of RC educate the local public about these issues. Director Glasbrenner continues to work on promoting all housing initiatives.

Mayor T. Coppernoll reported his attendance at a recent meeting at UWPR. Campus Representative, Melanie Platt-Gibson reports that the Provost stated, "We're not here to close the campus." The campus hopes to host local businesses and trainings for the local workforce, provide credentialing and professional development and provide a flexible bachelor degree in the future. The dorms/apartments (previously owned by the campus Foundation) are now privately owned which has made student housing more challenging.

M. Brewer, County Board Chairman spoke up about the positives of the Richland Economic Development Office and Director Glasbrenner. He believes the city and the county have made great gains the past two years through this office.
