- 1) The meeting was called to order by David Scribbins at 2:00 p.m.
- 2) Proof of Notification: Linda Batten verified the posting.

 - Angela Metz said she has noticed people not stopping.
 - David said there is a proposal to have parking spots for cars 4 feet from the intersection instead of the current 15 feet. This will make it more difficult for both drivers and pedestrians to see each other.
