of a contagious or infectious disease, it shall be removed from the exhibit and slaughtered or quarantined as directed by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection.

- Vet Check-In Sheet. You must have the sheets properly filled out when bringing in your animals, along with ID numbers and vet inspection certificate and/or test papers. All vet check-in sheets MUST be filled out and given to the Department Superintendent. Those who DO NOT have their sheets filled out will not be checked in and will be asked to leave. Once animals are in place, they will be checked by the fair vet in the barns starting at 5 p.m.

- **Numbered leg bands** will be required on all poultry and pigeons (exhibitor's responsibility).
