## **Fur Bearing Animals**

- Vet Check-In Sheet. You must have the sheets properly filled out when bringing in your animals, along with ID numbers. All vet check-in sheets MUST be filled out and given to the Department Superintendent. Those who DO NOT have their sheets filled out will not be checked in and will be asked to leave. The vet check is in the barns at 5 p.m. Animals must be in place and paperwork filled out completely prior to 5
- Rabbits will be checked in by the Fair Superintendents and animals with health concerns will be examined by the fair veterinarian for further consideration.
- All rabbits must be tattooed with an identification number. Rabbits with tattoos written in the ear with a permanent marker WILL NOT be accepted. If any rabbits need to be tattooed before the fair, Cindi Harris (608-537-2059) IN ADVANCE.
- When transporting animals into the fair, all cages MUST be clean. Any questionable cages will be addressed at time of CHECK-IN and exhibit will be dismissed from the fairgrounds. There will be no additional check-in times and entry fee will not be reimbursed, so be sure to clean cages ahead of time.
- Rabbits showing evidence of a specific disease cannot be exhibited at any fair. If at any time any animal in the group shows evidence of a contagious or infectious disease, it shall be immediately removed from the exhibit or guarantined as directed by the department superintendent or other fair official.
- Rabbits in poor condition will not be permitted to be shown at the fair.
- No rabbits with babies are permitted.
- Only rabbits entered in the fair are permitted on the fairgrounds.
- Cages, water, and feed dishes will be provided. Exhibitors must bring feed and is responsible for daily care for their animals.
- Exhibitors may not show more than **THREE** breeds. Judging will be face-to-face on Friday, 9 am. All rabbits (except fryers and meat pen) must be officially identified and tattooed by July 15 of exhibit year and registered with the Extension Office. Single fryers and meat pen rabbits must be officially identified and tattooed by August 15 of exhibit year and registered with the Extension Office.
- Enter rabbits by sex and age.

### CLASS – BARN-CAGE MANAGEMENT

Youth organizations are required to participate in Rabbit Cage Management and must submit an online entry made out in the name of the youth organization at the time Junior entries are due and pay the entry fee. The prizes will be given upon the basis of clean, neat, well-kept stalls/cages and exhibit evidence of good livestock care and management, and attitude and behavior of exhibitors.

Meat Pen to consist of 3 rabbits - All rabbits shall be of the same breed and variety (not necessarily purebreds). No rabbit may be over 10 weeks of age and 3.5 to 5.5 pounds in weight. Theses rabbits may not be entered in any other class.

Roaster Rabbit - A single rabbit, either sex, must be under 6 months of age and 5.5 to 9 pounds in weight; may not be entered in any other class.

Single Fryer - Not over 10 weeks of age and 3.5 to 5.5 pounds in weight; may not be entered in any other class.
