Explanation of categories:

- **Original Leather Project (No Kits):** Designed and cut out by project members.
- **Non-Original Leader Project (Kits):** Readymade store bought or ready to be assembled.
- **Original Design:** Not ready made; must be created by project members.
- **Non-Original Design:** Pattern that came with kits or is not member's own creation.
- **Leather Projects:** Will be judged on basis of workmanship, structure (design, size, shape). Fulfilling the purpose designed for (if case or holder try to show it with object it was designed for).
- **Project design** may be kept simple for beginners and more complex for advanced members. Patterns should include cutting, application of pattern (stamping, tooling, carving, etc.), punching lacing holes, lacing, stitching, finishing or waxing of leather.
- **Only one (1) item per entry in all classes**

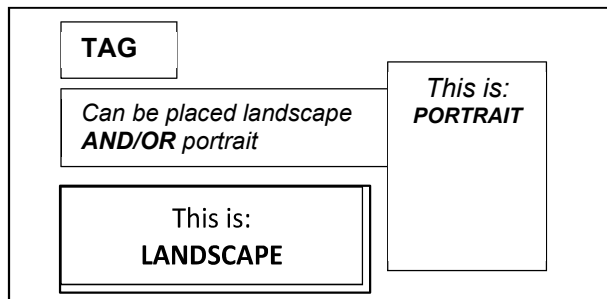

- **ALL PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOS, both OPEN and JUNIOR must be entered on Tuesday ONLY of fair exhibit week.**
- All exhibits must be tagged and given to the photography superintendents by **6 p.m. SHARP**.
- Entries **will not** be accepted on Thursday of fair exhibit week.



MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS:

All entries must be mounted on **11"x14" HORIZONTAL tagboard/poster board**. Please allow room for the entry tags (2 ½ x 3 ½) in the upper left-hand corner of tagboard/poster board. Entry tags should be firmly attached to upper left-hand corner, not covering photos or hanging over edge of tagboard/poster board. The required number of photos (4"x6", 5"x7" or 8"x10") will fit on the 11"x14" tagboard/poster board placed either/or horizontal (landscape) and/or vertical (portrait). **See diagram.**

All photography entries **must** include the following:

- A title for each entry, or a caption for each individual photograph
- Type of camera (e.g. digital, digital device such as phone camera, iPod, iPad, etc., 35 mm, etc.) in **lower right-hand corner** of each poster
- No embellishments (stickers, glitter, etc.) on photo(s) or tag/poster board
- Matting photos on tag/poster board is allowed
- Tag/Poster board can be any color
- No date stamp on front of photos
- Photographs will be judge on the basis of technical quality, composition and storytelling ability
- **The same photo cannot be used in any other entry.**
- **All photographs and videos must not have been displayed before at the Richland County Fair.**
- All photographs in each entry must be mounted on one sturdy **11"x14"** piece of tag/poster board.
- All photographs should be 4"x6" unless otherwise stated.

Photography Definitions:

- **Portrait** - is of a person or person(s) - photograph can be horizontal or vertical
- **Still Life** - objects or lighting arranged by photographer
- **Landscape** - an expanse of scenery that can be seen in a single view.
