Please bring your immunization record to the clinic. Signature of a parent or legal guardian is necessary on our permission form, unless child is 18 years of age.

School Immunization Requirements 2024-2025

For entry to kindergarten through seventh grade, students need:

- 4 doses of polio vaccine
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 4 doses of DTaP/DTP/DT/TD
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox)
- 2 doses of MMR
- 1 Tdap at seventh grade
- 1 MenACWY-containing vaccine at seventh grade

For entry to 12th grade

- 2 MenACWY-containing vaccines
