My 3 year old, 10 Lb. Toy Rat Terrier was attacked by Kristi Brown's approximately 70 Lb, Husky of 11952 Richwood rd. Blue River wi 53518, (608)-739-1158.

On 12-19-21 at around 6:30 p.m. I let my dog named "Peanut" outside to go potty. I walked over to the kitchen sink to get a glass of water and I heard him screaming from outside. I ran out on the porch and peanut was just screaming his head off.

At the bottom of my porch steps I saw Dakota Brown standing. I started yelling "Peanut where are you, where are you?" Dakota pointed at the ground 11 feet from him. I ran down the steps and saw my "Peanut" in the husky's mouth. I tackled the husky to the ground and pried open his mouth to free Peanut. I held him down until Dakota said he had him. Dakota Brown is Kristi's son who lives with her down the street from me.

There has been numerous times Dakota and his sister have come over in search of their dog. They have been to my house several times in the last couple of years in search of this dog. Almost every time I have to put a pair of leather gloves on and catch their dog for them because they are too afraid he will bite them. He has shredded a couple pairs of my gloves and made my hands bleed a couple of times. (Very aggressive dog).

We rushed Peanut to Muscoda Veterinary Clinic where they bandaged him up and gave him a pain killing shot. They sent us to a vet clinic in Middleton. After arriving there they sent us to UW Veterinary Care in Madison, (608) 263-7600. He is in critical care under Dr. Chele Lathrum. The damages inflicted on his body are extremely critical. The Estimated cost of care is in excess of \$15,000.00.

We tried contacting Kristi Brown by phone and at her residence to talk about the incident but didn't receive any response. On 12-20-2021 we notified the Richland County Sheriff Department and explained to them what happened. They said they were going to send a Deputy to talk to her.

My biggest concern is the husky might attack my grandkids when they are outside playing. He has bit my other dogs in the past. This all has happened on my property. I feel this dog should be put down so more of this doesn't happen. My wife and I are very heartbroken and hope that peanut will pull through.
