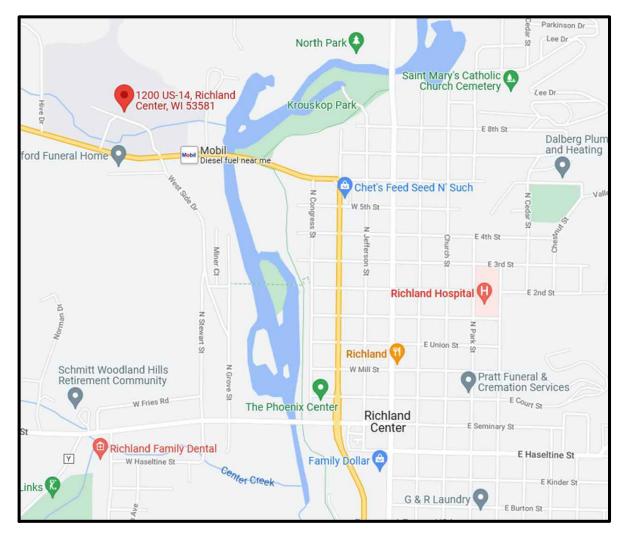

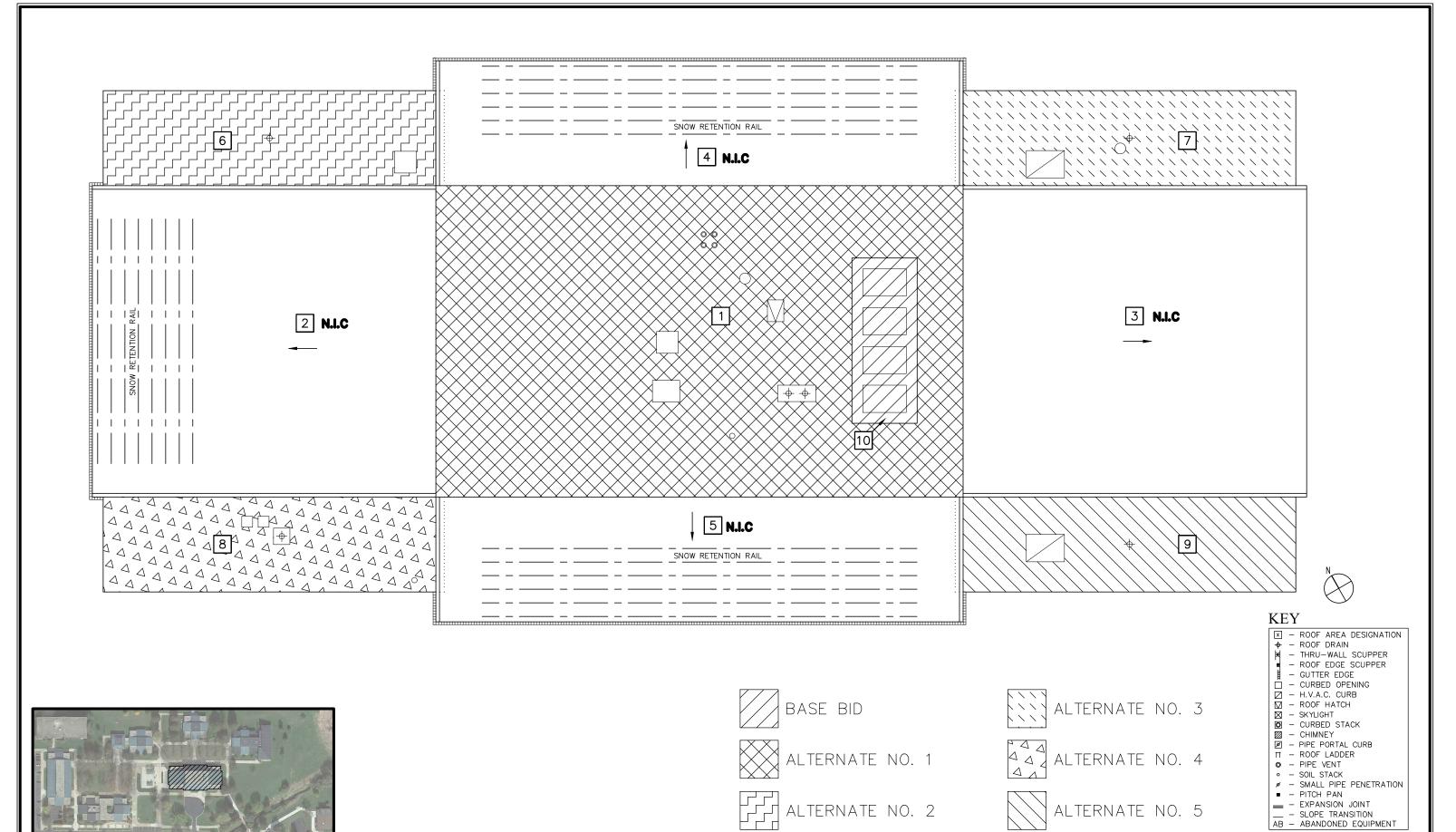

J. Michael Collins a family economics specialist for the Division of Extension. He is also the faculty director of the **Center for Financial Security** and the Fetzer Family Chair in Consumer & Personal Finance in the School of Human Ecology. He is also a Professor at the La Follette School of Public Affairs, and an affiliate of the Institute for Research on Poverty and Center for Demography and Ecology.

Collins studies consumer decision-making in the financial marketplace, including the consumer credit, savings and investment choices. His work includes the study of financial capability with a focus on lowincome families. He is also the director of the UW-Madison Retirement and Disability Research Consortium (RDRC) for the Social Security Administration.

Collins founded PolicyLab Consulting Group, a research consulting firm working with national foundations and government agencies, and co-founded **SpringFour**, an online database for local support services used in the financial industry. He also worked for NeighborWorks America (Neighborhood Reinvestment Corporation) and the Millennial Housing Commission. He holds a Masters from the John F. Kennedy School of Government, a PhD from Cornell University, and a BS from Miami University (OH).

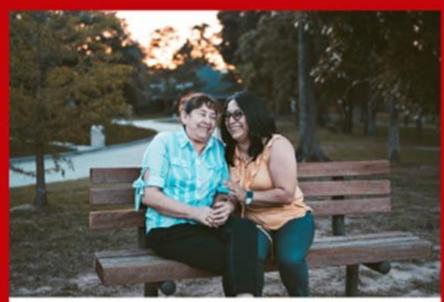

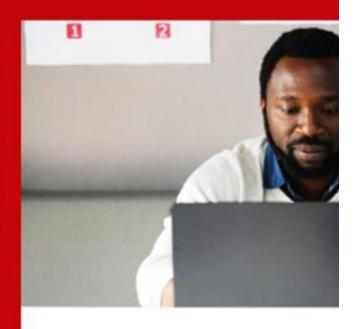

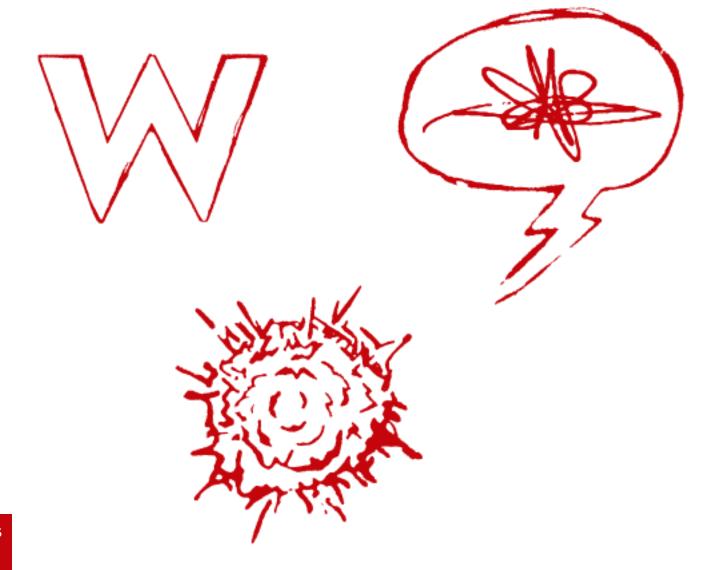
