UW CAMPUS UTILITY COSTS

In reviewing the Energy Bills for the UW Campus, I am presenting to you what the minimum, average and maximum costs for Utilities and Insurance was for 2022.

Water and Sewer for the most part are metered per building. The Electrical is in building groups.

There is a Protection & Public Benefits fee assessed to each bill that doesn't change regardless of use.

Electric, sewer and water is grouped with the Gym, Melville Hall, Library and Tennis Court. The 2nd group for electric and gas is Science Building, Coppertop and Classroom. The sign is on its own meter.

The Library, Classroom, Coppertop, Coppertop Admin and Gym all have their own gas, sewer and water meters.

Melvill has its own gas while sharing electric, sewer and water with other buildings.

The minimum cost for electric, sewer, water and gas is \$3,222.50 per month excluding the sign. Minimum months have general been September or October. Yearly minimum cost is \$38,670.00.

Average cost is \$4,868.82. Yearly average costs are \$58,425.81.

Maximum cost is \$8,034.51. Maximum months are generally February but it has varied to September – December. Yearly maximum is \$\$96,414.08.

Monthly insurance costs are \$1,458.34 with a yearly total of \$17,500.00.

Should the Coppertop be separated out, the average monthly costs to operate are \$6,795.21.
