Approve the Application and Acceptance of the 2024 85.21 Specialized Transportation Grant: Roxanne Klubertanz-Gerber explained that the 85.21 Specialized Transportation Grant is applied for every year through the department of transportation. The grant provides state financial aid for the Transportation program in the Aging and Disability Resource Center, and was approved by the Transportation Coordinating Committee along with the required 20% tax levy match of \$15,978. Motion by Lee VanLanduyt, seconded by Dr. Jerel Berres to approve the application and subsequent acceptance of the 2023 85.21 Specialized Transportation Grant, which includes the required 20% county match in the amount of \$15,978, and forward the recommendation onto the County Board for approval.




### HISTORY OF PLACEMENT TYPES

#### **Background:**

Richland County Health and Human Services, Child and Youth Services unit, has a family preservation worker that is leased through Southwest Wisconsin Workforce Development Board. This position is responsible for assisting parents in obtaining the education and skills needed to raise physically, psychologically and emotionally healthy children and to ensure child's safety while interacting with their parents.

We are requesting that this become a county position. We have had a Family Preservation Worker in the Child and Youth Services Unit in some capacity since 2011. Without this position, we would need to contract out this service as the case managers do not have the bandwidth to complete these tasks.

For each position that is with SWWDB, they receive a 7% fee. We would like to have this be a county position to save the 7% fee.

#### PURPOSE OF POSITION

The purpose of the position is twofold. One is to help parents obtain the education and skills needed to raise physically, psychologically, and emotionally healthy children. The second is to ensure child safety while providing interactions between children and their parents.

#### ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The following duties are normal for this position. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- → Provides individual training to parents in the area of child health, mental health and child development.
- > Coordinates services for children and families.
- > Assists in carrying out voluntary child welfare services, including making referrals to outside agencies.
- Advocates appropriately for the children and families being served.
- Facilitates safe and appropriate interaction between parents and their children through supervised visitation.

#### **November 2023 HHS Unit Updates**

#### **Behavioral Health Update**

Outpatient Clinic: Our providers have been very busy. Our psychiatric nurse has done an amazing job at filling their schedules. All three providers are starting to book out until 2024. We have one psychologist, one psychiatrist, and one psychiatric nurse practitioner.

CST: Our CST program has seen an increase in referrals over the last couple of months.

CCS: Our two new facilitators are up and running with almost full caseloads. Our other facilitator has consistently had a full caseload since she was hired. We continue to see an increase in CCS referrals.

Mental Health: Our two mental health providers continue to build their caseloads. They are starting to get trained in different areas to offer more treatment options for Richland County residents. One of our mental health therapists is starting a course to get her AODA license, and will then become a dual diagnosis provider.

APS/Crisis: Both our APS and Crisis worker have remained very busy over the last month.

AODA: We have one AODA counselor on staff. She is close to getting her license, and then will be able to start building her caseload.

Treatment Court: Treatment Court is almost at full capacity. They currently have 14 participants, and the program is only capable of having 15. We will be working on completing the 2024 TAD grant in the next couple of weeks.

Overall the Behavioral Health Unit is thriving. We are getting referrals daily for at least one of our programs. Some of our staff were on WRCO to educate the community on the services we provide. We have such a great team of hardworking individuals that are truly passionate about helping the residents of Richland County.

#### **Economic Support**

Both of our new workers have made it through the State's ESS New Worker Training. Koral has been taking some phone calls on the call center. Hannah is working through casework training and will be venturing into phones soon. We are pleased with the progress.

All workers are busy learning the programs again, post COVID. Part of this learning process is getting all the consortium workers together to learn from each other and to meet the people they are working with. On November 14, 2023, the call center will close in order for staff to gather together in Madison for trainings. The consortium is allowed to close the consortium one day per year for this type of training. This is a day for workers to look forward to, as it is a break from their regular stressful day to learn and build comradery with their fellow ESS throughout the consortium.

#### **ADRC**

The ADRC of Eagle Country's Regional Director John Grothjan has left his position to take on the position of Director of the Office of Resource Center Development at the state. The Region has appointed Ingrid Kovars as the Interim Director and will re-evaluate structure of the Regional office over the next few months to see what the staffing needs will be going forward.

The transportation program is offering trips through the Richland Center Rotary Lights December 14<sup>th</sup> and the La Crosse Rotary Lights on December 12<sup>th</sup>.

Dementia Live was provided to the Nutrition programs meal site workers and volunteers and also to the Transportation programs volunteers on October 31<sup>st</sup>. The next Dementia Live event will be held in December to train EMS.

The ADRC is still recruiting for the ADRC Specialist position which has been open since the September retirement of Karn Schauf. Along with having an open position staff have seen a large increase in contacts over the last couple of months.

Joanne Welsh the ADRC's Elder Benefit Specialist has announced she will be retiring effective January 5th, after 39 years of service. Joanne is an expert in her field and will be sorely missed. We will start the recruitment process to fill her position in December.

#### **Public Health**

Mass vaccine flu clinics in the Richland County schools were completed during the month of October over the course of 3 weeks; schools covered were Richland, Ithaca, Weston, and St. Mary's. Flu shots were also provided at other sites in the community during the month of October, both regular and high dose; 2 flu vaccine clinics were advertised for and provided at RCHHS. Public Health will be offering flu shots at the senior dining meals sites in November and other community clinics will be provided, along with a clinic being offered for the Spanish-speaking population in coordination with free clinic staff.

COVID vaccines are available through the VFC program (Vaccine for Children) at no charge for uninsured and underinsured kids up to age 19. We are still awaiting the go-ahead for our BAP (Bridge Access Program) COVID vaccines for uninsured or underinsured adults only; this supply has not yet arrived to the health department as we are awaiting one more signature.

Troy Moris continues to provide environmental health consultation and home visits 2 times per month on site at Richland County, until his departure. His last day with Richland County public health will be on December 20th. Troy continues to provide training and consultation to the PH staff.

All public health staff are very busy learning new specific job-related tasks, as well as receiving training from regional and state programs that will be important to their new roles.

#### **Child and Youth Services**

Marissa Banker started with us on Monday, November 6, as the new CYS case manager. There continues to be one case management position open.

Shelby Miller is currently out on maternity leave.
