b. Highway - 2022 Projects-Status Update

Discussion:

- Winter Maintenance:
 - Currently have nine[9] trucks down and in need of repair which means there are not enough trucks for employees.
 - o Taking applications for Shop Superintendent.
 - Taking applications for Mechanics
- Building Maintenance:
 - Emergency purchase of two[2] garage doors. All remaining doors, which were budgeted for replacement in 2023, will be send out for bids.

9. Referendum Update [Supervisor Carrow]

Discussion: A brief status update regarding the referendum. The Ad Hoc Committee met, discussed, and concluded to exclude the referendum from the spring ballot.

10. Discussion and Possible Action on a Compensation Package for Employees [Highway]

Discussion: A compensation package for employees would be an incentive to hire/retain employees as well as keep competitive with the private sector. The compensation package would include:

- Tool allowance for mechanics of \$1,000 per calendar year
- Uniform expenses reimbursed/covered
- Mechanics/Equipment Operators/Patrolmen would receive \$1.00 per hour increase for weather related events [labled as: hazard pay]

These nearby counties offer their employees a similar compensation package [for research/reference]: Vernon, Grant and Lacrosse.
