The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Polivka, with Commissioner Burchill, Commissioner Carver, Commissioner Williamson, Commissioner Fleming and Marc Higgs present. Commissioner Burchill made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Fleming. The motion carried.
