The Richland County Fair & Recycling Committee has a Citizen Member vacancy. This vacancy is for a working member of the Committee who will be committed to the vision and mission of this office within Richland County. Applicant must be able to provide strategic direction, work and communicate fully with the Office Coordinator, full committee, other county departments, youth organizations, families and event holders. This Citizen Member must be informed on all issues that affect the work that will need done while holding this position. Some of the duties will consist of but is not limited to working 1 to 2 Recycling Events per year, availability the week prior to the fair in September, the week of the fair and week following along with possible availability during scheduled events held at the grounds. The Member should be able to drive a skidster, lift a minimum of 50lbs, enjoy long hours during the fair and be mechanically inclined. Please understand that these hours needed are not your typical 8-5 and do include evenings and weekends, at times. Applicant shall not be an elected official of Richland County and shall reflect the diversity of the community.

Interested applicants must be able to attend monthly meetings the third Wednesday of each month, from 5:00 pm- 8:00 pm (those hours will vary based on agenda). A \$30 per diem plus mileage is paid to each member in attendance by electronic deposit.
