RICHLAND COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFERS DRIVE-THRU INFLUENZA IMMUNIZATION CLINICS

Richland Center, WI: Richland County Health & Human Services will be offering the following drive-thru Public Health **INFLUENZA** Immunization Clinics at the **Richland County Fairgrounds** in October:

Wednesday, October 14th	1pm-4pm
Wednesday, October 21st	9am-Noon
Wednesday, October 28th	1pm-4pm

At this time, Public Health does not have any vaccines available for individuals over 65 years of age, their supply of vaccines for those 18-64 years is minimal, but they do have a healthy supply of vaccines for school-aged children. Influenza immunizations will be available on a **FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVE** basis. Individuals have to be a Richland County resident and should bring along their health insurance card for processing. If you do not have health insurance, the following fees will be charged: \$65.00 for the high dose vaccine and \$40.00 for the quadrivalent product. Only EXACT checks or cash will be accepted, as we WILL NOT exchange cash with individuals. Please bring a pen so we can obtain your signature and wear a mask when interacting with our site workers.

The Richland Hospital is also offering **INFLUENZA** immunizations Monday-Friday by appointment only. Please contact the hospital main number (608) 647-6321 or clinic main number (608) 647-6161 BEFORE coming to the facility. **INFLUENZA** immunizations will also be offered at the Muscoda Health Center from 9am-5pm October 16th, 21st & 30th and at the Spring Green Medical Center from 9am-5pm every Thursday in October.
