EXTREME HEAT PREDICTED BY NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE

Richland Center, WI: The National Weather Service is predicting extreme heat for our

area beginning Saturday night and continuing into next week. High temperatures are

expected to reach between 95-105 degrees with a heat index of 110-115 degrees. These

temperatures could continue for 5 or more days, which could lead to a heightened risk of

heat-related illnesses, especially for those who are sensitive to the heat.
