Re: Extreme Heat Advisory

EXTREME HEAT PREDICTED BY NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE

The National Weather Service has issued a heat advisory for our area from noon until 7 pm today. High

temperatures are expected to reach 97-99 degrees with a heat index of 100-105 degrees. High temperatures

are expected to continue and could lead to a heightened risk of heat-related illness, especially for those who

are sensitive to heat.

Individuals needing water or air conditioning may cool off from 8 am to 5 pm today and Friday in

Conference Room 2 of the Richland County Courthouse located at 181 West Seminary Street in Richland

Center. The Brewer Public Library located at 325 N. Central Avenue in Richland Center is also available for

people needing to cool off and will be open from 10am to 8pm today, 10am to 5pm on Friday, and 10am to

2pm on Saturday. Officials will monitor the use of cooling centers and the weather to determine the

continued need for cooling centers into next week.
